In two weeks, we created a team consisting of eight companies and 60 volunteers. Steven and I did this, with our board, because it was the right thing to do during this pandemic and because we wanted to bring attention to the fact that many vets, who have sacrificed for our great country, are suffering. For our first effort in attempting this - it was a success. We made an profound impact on many lives. As I said on the news that day:

"Our veterans are to be held in exceptional esteem. They are a national treasure to all of us"

During this event we met a Gold Star Family - Ed and Mary Miller. They lost their son on his second deployment to Iraq. Ryan was killed in action protecting us on September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2006. I had a poster made for the Miller's of their son which we displayed at St. Francis DeSales and at Eddie Merlot's:





We gave this banner to the Miller's on Saturday. Despite what any of us feel we have been through over the past two months, I assure you, what we have experienced is nothing compared to what the Miller's have had to endure having lost their son, Ryan, who died protecting all of us...

We owe The Miller's and all of our Gold Star Families our eternal thanks and gratitude.

As we commence the process of re-opening our economy, we need to understand that things will not be normal for a while, but we will re-open. Anecdotally, Eddie Merlot's opened last Thursday with 200+ guests each night. Scott Ciocca, their GM told me he could have booked 400 each night, so that's a good sign demand is returning. We also wanted to thank the media for their effort last weekend. Both WBNS-10 and WSYX-6 covered our event at Eddie's last weekend.
